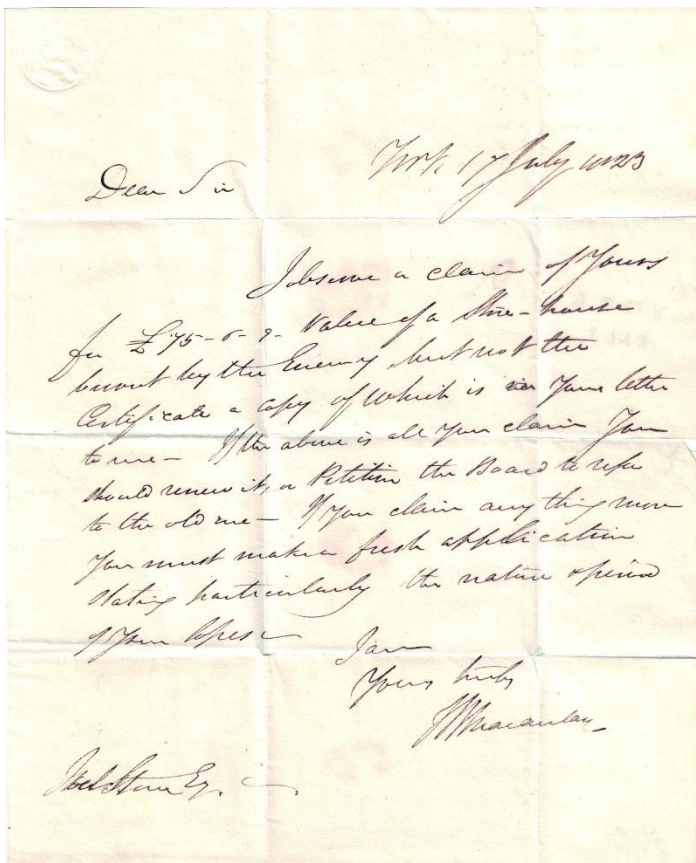
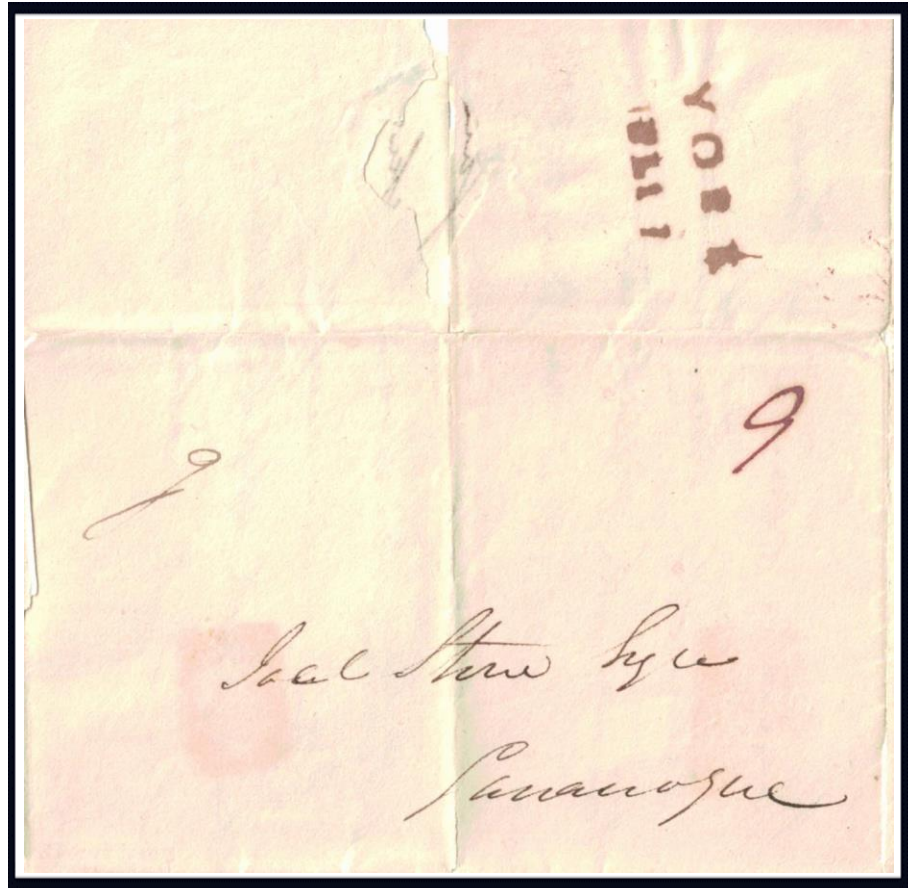


Military Toronto – War of 1812 – 1823 letter regarding damaged shed

The distance from York to Gananoque as listed on the postal charts of the time is 201 miles and the rate as 11d. Had the distance from Gananoque to York been 200 miles the 9d rate would have been correct.

War of 1812 – Reparations Claim

From T.W. Macaulay to Col. Joel Stone
(founder of Gananoque and participant in
he first actions of the War of 1812).

Dear Sir

I observe a claim of yours
for £75-6-9 value of a stone-house
burnt by the Enemy but not the
certificate, a copy of which is in your letter
to me – If the above is all you claim you
should renew it, or Petition the Board to ref
to the old one – if you claim any thing more
you must make a fresh application
stating particularly the nature ???
of your ???
